SUBJECT: ADP Phased Multiple Language Launch and IATF Database Impact

The purpose of this communiqué is to advise all IATF certification bodies and their auditors that IATF has agreed to release the following languages in a two phased approach rather than release all the languages on 31st March 2009 as originally communicated in CB Communiqué 2008-005.

The 31st March 2009 launch will include the following languages;

- Czech
- French
- German
- Japanese
- Simplified Chinese
- Castilian Spanish

For auditors selecting one of the above languages in the ADP as their preferred language, and whose current IATF auditor credentials expire before 31st May 2009, will be extended to the 30th June 2009.

The 12th May 2009 launch will include the remaining languages;

- Italian
- Korean
- Polish
- Portuguese
- Russian
- Latin American Spanish
- French with Audio translation

For auditors selecting one of the above languages (released 12th May 2009) in the ADP as their preferred language, and whose current IATF auditor credentials expire before 31st May 2009, will be extended to the 30th September 2009.

In order to activate these extensions Global Oversight requires Certification Bodies to ensure their auditors both full time and sub-contract register in the ADP at <http://support.iatfadp.com/> by the 30th April 2009 and select their preferred language.

Certification Bodies are not required to pay for registered auditors by the end 30th April 2009 but all auditors must be registered in the ADP.
