



IATF Guidance on the application of Customer Specific Requirements (CSR) and Supplier Codes

The purpose of this OEM Communiqué is to advise all IATF Certification Bodies of guidance on the applicability of Customer Specific Requirements (CSR) and suppliers codes for suppliers to the Groupe PSA (including its subsidiaries, affiliated brands and joint ventures).

Groupe PSA (incl. subsidiaries, affiliated brands and joint ventures)	Groupe PSA (Peugeot Citroen, DS, Opel, Vauxhall)	Joint Venture
Which supplier code should be entered into the IATF Database if more than 1 supplier code exists for the same site?	The manufacturing site code registered in the PSA database called "SPOT" – this is to be checked by the supplier.	N/A
Is the IATF OEM scorecard used for suppliers to these organizations? If not, what is used?	YES	NO (specific JV scorecard)
Are the suppliers required to meet the COMPANY OEM CSRs?	YES	NO (specific JV CSR)

NOTE: * Supplier code is for Groupe PSA (only one supplier code per supplier site, the same for Peugeot, Citroen, DS, Opel and Vauxhall brands). All new suppliers to Groupe PSA must make a request for a COFOR code in B2B portal: <http://b2b.psa-peugeot-citroen.com>.

All Opel and Vauxhall suppliers shall ask for a COFOR code by this way.

If the supplier does not know its company's supplier code, the supplier can contact the B2B Portal Assistance in the section "get an access" in the website.

Joint ventures (as DPCA or CAPSA) apply their own requirements to suppliers. No supplier code is required to be entered in the IATF database.
