Systematic Review Team Structure

To ensure a robust transition and faster correction response to identified requirements or audit process issues, the IATF 16949 Systematic Review Team:

- Is comprised of OEMs, National Associations and Oversight Offices
- Receives input from OEMs, suppliers, CBs, auditors and Oversight Offices
- Meets regularly to consider and publish FAQs and Sanctioned Interpretations
 - For the Rules or the IATF 16949 standard
- Meets more frequently if additional input is received
- Was responsible for the FAQs and SIs issued after the Stakeholder Conference in Germany, September 2017
- Will be responsible for considering of other major inputs, such as ISO changes, potentially requiring the publication of a new standard
- Planning to meet more frequently to consider the input from this conference



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Systematic Review Team Results

The IATF 16949 Systematic Review Team has achieved the following to address challenges identified during the transition to IATF 16949:

- Published 11 Frequently Asked Questions clarifying requirements without changing the intent
- Published 9 Sanctioned Interpretation correcting wording or requirements to improve the transition process
- Is finalizing two more FAQs and two more SIs to address additional areas needing clarification or correction
- Continues to receive inputs and suggestions through the following
 - Suppliers communicate through the National Associations
 - OEMs communicate to the OEMs on the team
 - Auditors, CBs and Oversightes communicate through the Oversightes
- Please continue to provide your valuable inputs during this conference and at all other times – especially if a requirement or rule is impeding transition to IATF 16949
