The purpose of this OEM Communiqué is to advise all IATF Certification Bodies of guidance on the applicability of Customer Specific Requirements (CSR) and supplier codes for suppliers to Groupe Renault (including its subsidiaries, affiliated brands and joint ventures).

Numbering Scheme / Structure of Supplier Codes (if applicable)	COFOR CODE including supplier plant number "6digit-2digit" The first 6 digits are the COFOR number and the last 2 digits are the supplier plant number Note: any zeroes ahead of the "6digit-2digit" format, if present, are to be ignored Example: 679822-77	N/A
