



IATF Guidance on the application of Customer Specific Requirements (CSR) and Supplier Codes



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The purpose of this OEM Communiqué is to advise all IATF Certification Bodies of guidance on the applicability of Customer Specific Requirements (CSR) and suppliers codes for suppliers to the FCA US LLC.

FCA US LLC (incl. subsidiaries, affiliated brands and joint ventures)	
Numbering Scheme / Structure of Supplier Codes (if applicable)	Supplier codes used by FCA US LLC consist of a five digit number and an optional one or two letter suffix (e.g. "12345", "12345A" or "12345AB").
Can more than 1 supplier code exist for the same supplier (e.g. based on commodity, currency, etc.)?	YES
Is a supplier code required to be entered in the IATF Database? *	YES



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Which supplier code should be entered into the IATF Database if more than 1 supplier code exists for the same site?	The supplier code with the most commercial activity (highest Value of Business) should be used. (FCA US LLC Quality representative can be contacted for guidance if there is no clear choice).
Is the IATF OEM scorecard used for suppliers to these organizations? If not, what is used?	NO
Are the suppliers required to meet the FCA US LLC OEM CSRs?	NO Application of FCA US LLC CSRs is at discretion of the organization unless explicitly specified by FCA CSRs (e.g. special process audits).
If not, are their own CSRs that have to be met?	---
